NCLE National Laser Certifications indicates a level of academic competency in operating medical/aesthetic laser equipment in a safe manner, by indicating a working knowledge of the basic underlying physical principles and safety involved with medical laser systems. An NCLE Laser Certified™ designation indicates a high level of professional competency, and knowledge of medical/aesthetic laser operation.

State licensure for different laser procedures varies in every state, please consult your State Medical Association. Some states require a National Laser Certification and others do not. Almost all that license users require Certificates of Training.

- Certified Laser Operator Aesthetic- CLO/A
- Certified Laser Assistant - CLA (Medical/Surgical)
- Certified Laser Operator Hair Removal - CLO/HR (International Aesthetic & Laser Association)
- Certified Medical Laser Safety Officer - CMLSO (Board of Laser Safety)
- Certified Laser Repair Technician - CLRT
- NCLE Laser Technology Certification - Product Specific for Mfg Device Training

Laser Course(s)

Proctored Written Examination: (available at some affiliated courses, or may be scheduled separately)

Educational Background: wide range from Bachelor degrees, MD, RN, CST, or Aesthetic licenses, and others.

Experience or Case Submissions : Varies by Certification

**QUALIFYING COURSES:** Any accredited laser course will meet the requirements for testing, but selected training programs are also authorized to administer the exams just after a review session.
